Application Deadline:

Qualifications:

- 1.** Played a minimum of 4 full and consecutive years with Lakeshore Storm and played the summer of HS Graduation.
(IF, an athlete leaves Lakeshore Storm and returns and still fulfills all qualifications, they will receive 1/2 of the Scholarship.)
- 2.** Maintained a cumulative 3.0 High School GPA and earned a minimum ACT score of 18
- 3.** Played 4 years of High School softball or baseball
- 4.** Must complete 20 hours of community service at the Storm Softball & Baseball Training Center by May 31st that is documented and approved by Storm Center Management
- 5.** A typed personal essay, discussing the following that will be placed on the Lakeshore Storm Softball & Baseball, Inc. website as a ***SUCCESS/TESTIMONIAL***
 - a. How many years have you played for Lakeshore Storm Softball & Baseball, Inc. ?
 - b. What is it about the organization that kept you playing the sport you love?
 - c. How has Lakeshore Storm helped you to develop the core values of respect, integrity, trust and excellence?
 - d. What college will you be attending, course of study, and will you be playing softball or baseball in college?
 - e. Submission of High School transcripts, ACT score, application and essay by May 31, 2019.

Scholarship Information:

Upon receiving all information, Lakeshore Storm Softball & Baseball, Inc. Executive Committee will approve each student/athlete's scholarship that has met all qualifications and will send notification to each member and the amount of their scholarship. All scholarship monies will be written out to the college or university of their choice and will not be written to an individual under any circumstance.
